# **About the Clean Water Financing and Assistance Program**

Mission: We provide cost effective funding solutions and technical assistance to localities, organizations, and citizens to protect and enhance water quality in the Commonwealth

"Funding solutions" – we provide low and no interest loans and grants from five funds:

- Virginia Clean Water Revolving Loan Fund
- Stormwater Local Assistance Fund
- Water Quality Improvement Fund
- Combined Sewer Overflow Fund
- American Rescue Plan Act Wastewater Funds



#### A bit about ARPA

#### **ARPA** signed into Law

- March 2021
- Support to state and local governments "in responding to the economic and public health impacts of COVID-19 and in their efforts to contain impacts on their communities, residents, and businesses."

# General Assembly appropriates \$\$ to DEQ

- Summer 2021 and 2022
- General Assembly directed DEQ to use for "septic, straight pipe, and sewer collection system repair, replacement, and upgrades."

#### DEQ develops Implementation Plan

- Summer/Fall 2022
- \$5 million for SLPP
- Funding solution that could fill in those eligibility gaps, like community septic systems, like those at a trailer park, or a business.



#### Implementation Plan

#### Program Design Outlines how the local partner will administer the program

- 50-100% cost share for septic repair/replacements or connection to public sewer
- Assigns or approves contractor; verifies permits

#### Applications L

Local partner administers cost-share funds

Local partner accepts and evaluates applications; approve/deny projects

#### Reimbursement

Local partner provides cost-share for approved project

- Participant requests reimbursement for pre-approved project
- Local partner issues cost-share payment (to participant or to contractor)



#### **Solicitation Overview**

- Solicitation Period
- Received 16 application

October – December 2022 January-March 2023


Evaluated applications

- Authorized \$8.2 million
- 13 of 15 applicants selected were new

## **Implementation**

SLPP Grant Deadlines	
<u>Milestone</u>	<u>Deadline</u>
Submit Program Design documents	9/30/2023
Execute grant agreement	3/31/2024
Disburse first septic BMP dollar(s)	3/31/2025
Disburse 50% of grant amount	12/31/2025

Meetings with each applicant

Program Design



#### **Program Design**

June-September 2023

Must submit Program Design by 9/30/2023



#### **Grant Agreement**

Now – March 2024

Meets other requirements and execute grant agreement



#### **Implementation Status - Today**

- 2 program designs approved (GWRC & City of Newport News)
- Expect multiple program designs and grant agreements complete by end of 2023
- Implementation felt at local level 2024-2026
- All funding must be spent by end of 2026
- Programs will stop soliciting applications in early/mid 2026
